José Martí, born in 1853 in Cuba, is revered throughout the world as a man who committed his life to social justice and Cuban independence from Spanish colonialism. He was a journalist, poet, diplomat, and revolutionary who laid his life fighting for the freedom of his homeland on May 19, 1895. Martí's life may have been a short one, but the legacy he left behind encircles universal themes, which remain relevant to this day, such as liberty, equality, education, peace, and dignity for all humans.

You can become a part of this tribute by expressing yourself through paintings, poetry, or other forms of artistic expression on any of the following themes:

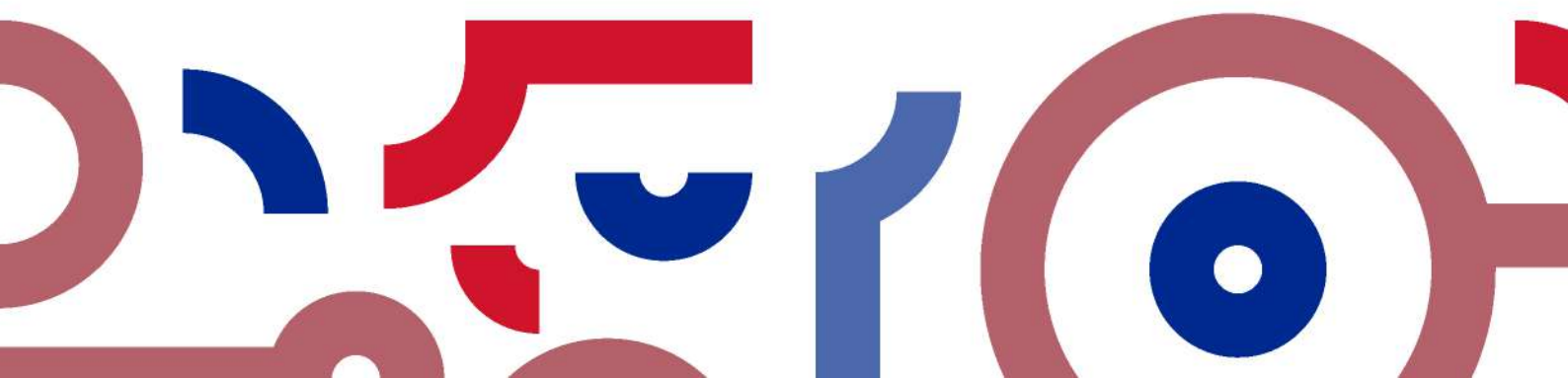
Liberty, Democracy, Equality, Unity, Peace, Justice, Education.

We shall also invite three students with the most unique artistic expressions:

- To join us in New Delhi\* on Thursday, 19th May 2022 for a screening of the movie *Eye of the Canary*,
- To showcase their work in front of dignitaries from around the world,
- To receive the latest Amazon Kindle device, and

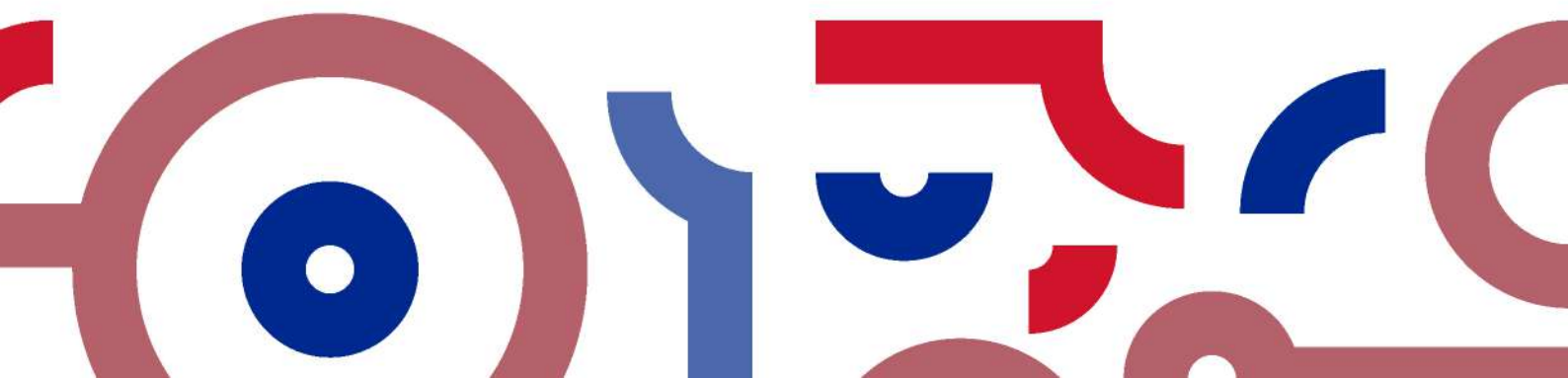
